



**ORDER OF THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF CONTRA COSTA  
RESCINDING AND AMENDING PRIOR ORDERS REQUIRING PERSONNEL IN  
CERTAIN HIGH-RISK SETTINGS TO WEAR FACE COVERINGS AND OBTAIN  
WEEKLY TESTING FOR SARS-COV-2 OR DOCUMENT THEIR FULLY  
VACCINATED STATUS**

**ORDER NO. HO-COVID19-49**

**DATE OF ORDER: JULY 23, 2021**

**Summary of the Order**

This Order of the Health Officer rescinds Health Officer Order No. HO-COVID19-47, issued on June 29, 2021, and corrects the number of an order issued on July 1, 2021, also numbered Health Officer Order No. HO-COVID19-47, effective immediately.

UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTIONS 101040 and 120175, THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF CONTRA COSTA (“HEALTH OFFICER”) ORDERS:

2. **Rescission of Order.** HO-COVID19-47, issued on June 29, 2021, is hereby rescinded.
3. **Amendment of Order.** HO-COVID19-47, issued on July 1, 2021, is hereby renumbered HO-COVID19-48.
4. **Effective Date and Time.** This Order takes effect immediately upon issuance.
